

TOURISM IN ECUADOR

Ecuador's Ministry of Tourism shares its commitment to reactivate the tourism sector in our country, under the understanding that the "new normality" will require profound changes. Technical specialized roundtables have been established with tourism private sector and their representatives to establish a new Biosafety Protocol for Restaurants and Cafeterias to be applied as soon as they reopen, as well as a Protocol for Accommodation and other documents for the rest of the tourism activities.

Starting June 1st, the Ministry of Transportation has announced the reopening of commercial flights. This will undoubtedly reactivate the tourism activities, under strict biosafety measures in both international airports of Quito and Guayaquil. To insure this, on May 15th, Quito's international airport, Mariscal Sucre, on conducted a practice drill to test the safety and biosafety protocols that will ensure the passengers health. As an additional measure, travelers coming into Ecuador will be required a PCR test to detect COVID 19.

Ecuador has the advantage that tourism coming into the country is not massive, but rather personalized, therefore travelers will find ample open space, pure air and all the biodiversity that nature has offered our singular country, thanks to its location in the middle of the world.
